




INTRODUCTION TO SHIP

The Office of Healthcare Policy Initiatives is responsible for this four-year model test grant that began on February 1, 2015.





Governor Otter pulled together healthcare leaders, providers and consumers to find solutions for Idaho's unsustainable, costly healthcare system.





Idaho Health Data Exchange was established to address the critical need for electronic exchange of health records.





The Idaho Medical Home Collaborative was established with commitment from Medicaid and the major commercial insurers in Idaho to Pilot the PCMH model with Primary Care Practices.

The Patient Centered Medical Home or PCMH is best described as a model or philosophy of primary care that is patient-centered, comprehensive, team based, coordinated, accessible, and focused on quality and safety.





Idaho was awarded a Center for Medicare & Medicaid Innovation planning grant to develop the State Healthcare Innovation Plan.





Governor Otter officially established the Idaho Healthcare Coalition (IHC) as the advisory group to the SHIP. This group of committed stakeholders helped develop the plan.





With the guidance and expertise of the coalition, the Department submitted a SHIP Model Testing grant proposal to the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation. Idaho was 1 of 10 awardees.


The Idaho Healthcare Coalition identified 7 goals as the priorities of the SHIP. Each of these goals is an operational component of our Model Test.

- 1 PCMH technical assistance, training and incentives
- 2 Connecting PCMHs to the Idaho Health Data Exchange
- 3 Establish seven Regional Health Collaboratives
- 4 Improve rural access to virtual PCMHs
- 5 Data gathering and analytics
- 6 Aligning payment mechanisms across payers
- 7 Reduce healthcare costs


PAYMENT REFORM



Multi-Payer Workgroup:

- Statewide payment transformation – each organization has a unique approach
- Incentivizing performance
- Adaptive model to each practice

Medicaid is restructuring the Healthy Connections and Health Home Programs to incentivize primary care providers to transform their clinics into patient centered medical homes.

COHORT 1 PCMH



Over 100 applications were received from Primary Care Clinics interested in participating in Year One. 55 practices were selected from across all seven (7) Regional Health Districts include urban, rural and frontier communities.
