

# The Day You Get Your SNAP (Food Stamps) May be Changing




Most SNAP recipients will **no longer** receive their benefits on the 1st of the month.

Starting July 1, SNAP benefits (also known as Food Stamps) will be available between the 1st and 10th day of the month, rather than all on the 1st.

The last digit of the cardholder's birth year will determine what day the household gets their SNAP (Food Stamps) each month.

Last digit of birth year of cardholder	SNAP benefits available on this day of the month
1	1 <sup>st</sup>
2	2 <sup>nd</sup>
3	3 <sup>rd</sup>
4	4 <sup>th</sup>
5	5 <sup>th</sup>
6	6 <sup>th</sup>
7	7 <sup>th</sup>
8	8 <sup>th</sup>
9	9 <sup>th</sup>
0	10 <sup>th</sup>

For example:



The cardholder with birth year **1982** will get SNAP benefits on the 2nd day of each month.
