Fully Breastfed	A fully breastfed infant will not receive a food package until s/he reaches 6 months of age	

Note: Infants greater than 6 months of age qualifying for Food package III may receive infant formula and exempt formula at the same MMA as infants ages 4 through 5 months of age if they are not receiving infant foods (cereal, fruit, vegetables).
