Idaho Emergency Medical Services **Physician Commission** (EMSPC)
February 11, 2011 Meeting

- **STEMI Toolkit:** Every agency's medical supervision plan must address ST Elevated Myocardial Infarctions (STEMIs). The EMS subcommittee of Cardiac Level-I has created resources to help make this happen. The resources have been endorsed on the EMSPC and will be available on their website for download. (The website is undergoing an upgrade so they should be posted after April 28th.) www.emspc.dhw.idaho.gov The tools can be used "as is" or can be modified to fit your agency's specific needs.

- Airway Management Data Reports:** Airway Management Data reports were sent to all ILS and ALS agency medical directors, training officers and agency administrators. The EMSPC encourages feedback on both the airway management survey and the airway management data report. Specific changes and wording are appreciated.

- CO Oximetry Monitoring Protocol:** The CO Oximetry Monitoring Protocol that is posted on the EMSPC website has been updated to include "Pediatric."

- Pulse Oximetry:** Pulse Oximetry will become an optional module (2,OM) for EMTB95s and a floor skill (X) for EMT2011s when the 2012-1 scope of practice becomes effective in the spring of 2012.
