This report lists agencies receiving award funds for the Fiscal Year 2015 Dedicated Grant.

Fiscal Year 2015 Dedicated Grant

Requests from EMS agencies for Fiscal Year 2015 Dedicated Grant totaled \$2,586,582.69 including \$2,172,151.00 for 26 vehicles and \$414,431.69 for equipment. The Dedicated Grant Fund is generated by a fee on driver's licenses and the Idaho Legislature appropriated \$1,196,409.63 for this year's disbursement. Of the total funds available, approximately 80% was awarded for vehicles and 20% was awarded for equipment.
