

Idaho Medicaid State Plan Benefit Options

The Idaho Medicaid State Plan is made up of the “Standard” State Plan which includes mandatory minimum benefits and three “Alternative Benefit” Plans (ABPs) that are aligned with health needs and include an emphasis on prevention and wellness. During the eligibility process, Medicaid applicants are offered the choice of the standard plan or a preferred alternative benefit plan. ABPs are the preferred plans because they offer more benefits designed to meet the health needs of the individual. Most applicants will have a choice of the standard plan or the Basic Plan. Only individuals who have disabilities or special needs can choose between the standard plan and the Enhanced plan. Plan changes can be made after enrollment based on changes in health status. The Medicare/Medicaid plan choice is designed specifically for individuals who have both Medicare and Medicaid coverage.

Basic Alternative Benefit Plan	The Basic Alternative Benefit Plan is designed for low income children and adults of average health. This plan includes all of the services on the Standard Plan and additional services that provide complete health, prevention, and wellness benefits for children and adults who don't have special health needs. Most Medicaid participants will be enrolled in this benefit plan. Outpatient Behavioral Health Services included in this plan are available through The Idaho Behavioral Health Plan under a statewide managed care contract. Participants who have disabilities or who have used the Enhanced Plan services in the past will be enrolled in this benefit plan.
