Access to Recovery 4 (ATR4) will provide approximately \$2.2 million per year for treatment and recovery support services across multiple populations, including homeless individuals and families.

Services available include:

- Outpatient Services (Individual, Group, Family Counseling)
- Case Management
- Safe and Sober Housing
- Drug Testing
- Transportation for Treatment Services
- Life Skills
- Recovery Coaching

Eligible populations will meet the following criteria:

- Income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Rate in the past 30 days
- Assessment shows client meets clinical eligibility
- Homeless within the past 30 days according to ATR 4 Definition of Homelessness

How do my clients access this funding?

Community-based organizations working with homeless individuals or families will help clients contact Business Psychology Associates (BPA) for a phone screening.

With your client present, call BPA at (800) 922-3406. Once you verify the client meets the ATR 4 Definition of Homelessness, BPA staff will screen your client for eligibility to receive ATR 4 Services.
