

# Navigating a Medication Center

## 4 Easy Steps

### **Step 1**

You will be given handouts and educational material at the first station. You may be asked to watch a short video. This is the opportunity to ask questions or notify staff that you need an interpreter. Follow the signs and move to the next station. Please follow directions as provided.

### **Step 2**

The forms you downloaded from the website and completed will be collected or a form will be provided for you to complete. Staff will review your form. Please have a list with the names, ages, weight, and allergies for each member of your family or household. You may be asked questions to determine what medications and/or treatment you will receive. You will sign consent forms to receive the medication and/or vaccination. Feel free to ask any questions you may have. Follow the signs and form a line to receive your medication at the next station. Please follow directions as provided.

### **Step 3**

You will receive your medication/vaccination to reduce your risk for tularemia and suited to your medical needs. You can also pick up medication for your household or group. Follow the signs and move to the next station. Please follow directions as provided.

### **Step 4**

You will be given follow up instructions and contact phone numbers if you have questions as you exit the facility. Carefully follow instructions for taking your medicine. It is important for you and your family to take all of the medicine that has been provided to you--even if you do not feel sick.
